



Important notes for Study Tours with overnight stays

Before booking any Friends` study tour please read the following:

The Friends of the Wilson does not accept any responsibility for your fitness to undertake the trip, itinerary or journey. By committing to a trip, you are declaring that you are in reasonable health and fit to travel, that you can mount and alight from the coach **unaided**, that you can carry your own luggage, and that you are fully aware of the itinerary. You are responsible for your own health and safety throughout the tour.

The Group Leader is one of our members who has volunteered to help, not a paid tour guide. We all need to be aware that it is their holiday too. Obviously, in emergency they will do their best to help.

Also Note

Members are required to have adequate travel insurance when travelling with The Friends of the Wilson and to provide proof of it when requested. Travel insurance is not included in the cost of any FOTW study tour. Some of the tour companies offer insurance, but it is members' own decision as to whether they purchase this or make their own insurance arrangements.

Coach drivers are **not insured** to assist passengers alighting from the coach or to carry passengers' luggage, other than loading it in and out of the hold of the coach. It is therefore passengers' responsibility to carry their own travelling-bags and to check that the driver loads them from the pavement into the coach.

If a hotel offers portorage, this will be stated clearly in the brochure.

Booking a FOTW study tour is confirmation that you have read, understood and accepted all the above.
