Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1 – We will depart from the Royal Well Coach Station, Cheltenham at 08.00hrs. and travel north, making an appropriate comfort stop with tea/coffee included at Coombe Abbey Hotel en-route for a private tour of Boughton House, Kettering known as 'The English Versailles'. Boughton House is owned by the Duke of Buccleuch and Queensberry. We will enjoy a set lunch shortly after our arrival. During the afternoon, our house guide will unveil one of Britain's grandest and best-preserved stately homes, where we will see one of Britain's most outstanding collections of fine art, furniture, tapestries, porcelain and carpets. We're booked for The King's Tour which is specially designed for the enthusiast, it covers two floors and about 20 rooms. Amongst the highlights will be a magnificent range of paintings by great artists, including El Greco, Gainsborough, Van Dyck, and John Wootton, exceptional French furniture by the master cabinetmaker André-Charles Boulle, alongside delicate Sèvres porcelain and Mortlake tapestries. We will ascend the grand entrance staircase and we will be shown the High Pavilion and State Apartments created for the visit of William III. After what is sure to be a wonderful, insightful visit the coach will depart for our hotel, the recently opened Telegraph Hotel, which is situated in the centre of Coventry. Here accommodation is reserved for two nights on a half board basis.

Day 2 - After breakfast, we will walk to St. Mary's Guildhall, which sits next to the Cathedral and dates back to 1352. It is home of the significant "Coventry Tapestry". Mary Queen of Scots was held here in 1569, it was a theatre for Shakespeare and an inspiration to George Eliot and miraculously survived the blitz of 1940 which devastated much of the city centre and stands as a monument to the power and wealth of medieval Coventry. With magnificent interiors, collections of armour, historic furniture, artworks and internationally important tapestries, the Guildhall offers a window into Coventry's glorious past. Group entrance and private guided tour are included.

After the visit we will have free time to visit some of Coventry's many places of interest including the Cathedral, the Coventry Transport Museum and the Herbert Art Gallery & Museum. During the mid/late afternoon the coach will transfer us to just beyond the city's ring road to visit Charterhouse, a Carthusian Priory of St Anne - a unique grade I listed 14th Century Carthusian Monastery and grounds, one of only nine ever built in Britain. The precinct walls and the Priors' House and refectory survive, together with an outstanding 14th-century wall painting of the Crucifixion which originally decorated one wall of the double-height refectory. Group entrance and a private guided tour is included. *Please note, the order of the included visits are subject to change.

Day 3 – We check out of the hotel following breakfast and board the coach for our return journey, travelling via Upton House & Gardens near Banbury. Upton House, originally built in 1695, became the home of Walter Samuel 2nd Viscount Bearsted, the only son of Sir Marcus Samuel founder of the Shell Transport & Trading Co. The family, as well as being 1930's millionaires and earning their money through the Shell Oil company, spent their fortune on a vast collection of tapestries,

The collection is still hung as Lord Bearsted intended. This is a National Trust property, therefore those who are National Trust members will be entitled to free admission, for those who aren't, the group rate of £11.70 per person will be added to their confirmation/invoice. Tea/ coffee will be included upon arrival, after which there will be free time to explore the honey-coloured country house with dramatic terraced gardens and world-renowned art collection. After what is sure to be a wonderful visit, we will continue our journey back to Cheltenham, arriving during the late afternoon.
